- Making school visits and connecting with Vocational/Technical instructors
- Establishing contacts with local shops, clubs and other collector car organizations
- Developing and cultivating contacts within your local area is key
- Participating in RPM events such as Shop Hop, the Concours Experience and Off To The Races With RPM
- Acting as an RPM mentor working with students directly by giving feedback about their resumes, cover letters of introduction, portfolios and other job placement advice. Training for this will be provided by RPM staff.
- Mentoring shop owners/employers on creating job descriptions and company profiles, as well as managing their expectations for their potential hires
- Supporting our fundraising efforts
